For the months of August and September, our focus was on providing the Under Twos with an environment that encourages them to explore Learning Dispositions like Courage and Curiosity whereby the children are able to find something of interest within the centre. The children have really enjoyed listening to CD books, dancing with props like ribbons, exploring different musical instruments and participating in messy play like gloop. With greater opportunities to interact with the bigger children in the Toddler group, we have noticed the children becoming more confident in initiating friendship and playing alongside them.

Over 2's Programme Planning

When new children start with us (as has happened in the last few months) we support them and their families during the transition period. Each child has a teacher and becomes part of the teacher's whanāu group. That teacher develops a close relationship with the family to best serve their child

Our daily programme allows new children and their families to familiarise themselves with our Centre, staff and daily routines.

Some of you have noticed that our vegetable and flower garden looks very good, it has survived the cold winter season. Our broad beans are getting bigger and are ready to be picked. Butterflies have also shown interest in our Swan Plants. So we might have some caterpillars soon.

Most of our children are into cooking and celebrating their birthdays. Do not be surprised if your child tells you they had a 2nd or 3rd birthday celebration in one week.
